

Getting to the Dubai International Stadium

The Dubai International Stadium is situated in the heart of Dubai Sports City.

Address

Dubai Sports City Gate No.1, Sheikh Mohamed Bin Zayed Rd. Dubai.

Getting here by public transport - Bus

The Dubai Cricket Stadium is serviced by two bus routes:

Please take care if walking from the bus stop to the stadium, as there are few pavements.

Getting here by public transport - Metro

You may need to get the metro to the bus stations. The nearest metro stations to the stadium are the Mall of the Emirates (R32) and Dubai Internet City (R34), which are on the **Red Line**. Trains run from 5am to midnight (every day of the week, except Sunday, when they start at 8am), every 3-5 minutes. Click here for the full map of the metro.

If you are coming from downtown Dubai, the best option is to take the metro to Dubai Internet City, followed by the F34 bus. This will cost 4 to 8.50 AED, depending on the number of zones passed. You can travel on both the metro and bus and it will count as a single journey so long as you check in on a bus within 30 minutes of checking out of a metro station. 
By car

The stadium is accessible from Hessa St/D61. Car parking spaces are as follows: 130 spots for Royal Parking, 250 spots for VIP (Grand Lounge), and 250 spaces next to G1 (outside the stadium).

In order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and congestion, where you have to travel by car, we encourage you to **lift share**.

Currently, the stadium sadly has no electric car parking charging places, but you will still be able to park your electric vehicle in the normal parking places.

Getting to Sharjah Cricket Stadium, Sharjah (Away Matches)

The Sharjah Cricket Stadium is located in Industrial Area 5 of Sharjah.

Address

Sharjah Cricket Stadium, Industrial Area 5, Sharjah.

Public transport

When travelling from Dubai to Sharjah, the nearest bus stop to the stadium is **City Center 1, Al Wahda Road, Sharjah,** which several interstate buses stop at, including:

- E303 bus from Union Square Bus Station (43 mins), approximately every 15 mins
- E306 bus from Al Ghubaiba Bus Station (36 mins), approximately every 15 mins
- E307 bus from Deira City Center Bus Station (25 mins), approx. every 15-60 mins
- E307A bus from Abu Hail Metro Bus Stop A3 (36 mins), approx. every 30 mins

Unfortunately, from City Centre 1, Al Wahda Road, Sharjah, there are no buses to the stadium, but you can take a short, 10-min taxi journey to Sharjah Cricket Stadium.

Alternatively, the **E315** bus goes from Etisalat Metro Station 24 to Al Muwaileh Terminal (58 mins). Again, there are no buses from here to the stadium, but you can take a short, 15-min taxi to the stadium.


By car

The stadium is accessible from the S117 road. In order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and congestion, where you have to travel by car, we encourage you to lift share.

Currently, the stadium sadly has no electric car parking charging places, but you will still be able to park your electric vehicle in the normal parking places.

Getting to Zayed Cricket Stadium, Abu Dhabi (Away Matches)

The Sheikh Zayed Cricket Stadium is positioned on the outskirts of Abu Dhabi city.

Zayed Cricket Stadium, Abu Dhabi Cricket & Sports Hub, Khalifa City, Abu Dhabi.

Public transport

Three interstate buses run between Dubai and Abu Dhabi: E100 (leaving from Al Ghubaiba), E101, and E102 (both leaving from Ibn Battuta Bus Station, which is accessible via the Red Line on the metro). The best option is the E102, which stops at Abu Dhabi Airport Terminal A, the closest bus stop on these routes to the stadium. From there, you can take a taxi to the stadium.

By car

The Abu Dhabi Cricket & Sports Hub, where the stadium is located, is accessible from Al Mabrouk Street, which is just off the E20 road. In order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and

congestion, where you have to travel by car, we encourage you to lift share.
